4. What does it mean to be 'thirsty'?

5. What does it mean to overcome/conquer?

6. What does it mean to daily life that God's word is true & trustworthy?
(a) What causes Christians to trust in things other than God?

7. What does it mean that Jesus is the Alpha and Omega?
(a) How does this bring us hope?

8. What strikes you from this passage? Why?
